

Dates

EUA (Pfizer) ~ December 10 (anticipated) EUA (Moderna) ~ December 17 (anticipated)

Administration as soon as 36 hrs post EUA

Quantities

6.4M doses (3.2M people) ASAP 40M doses (20M people) by 12/31


Prioritization

- State Distribution Plans Due to Feds 12/4, but CDC/ACIP Guidance Released 12/1
- Doses for 20M ppl by 1/1 (24M ppl in Phase 1A)
- Fed Distribution to States
 Proportionate by Population


Recommendations


- Lobby State for Prioritization Move Up to 1A (ie, IL residents, private duty staff)
- Stay in Close Contact with State Health Department (re: vaccine scheduling, prioritization, central vaccine locations)
- Vaccinate Residents Before Staff
- Put in Place a Post Phase 1 Plan Now (How to Administer Vaccine to Newly Arriving Residents/Staff)




U.S. adults who say if a vaccine were available today, they...























Compliance – Battling Vaccine Misinformation

Recommendations

- Mandate Staff Vaccination
- Request Liability Releases from Residents and Staff Who Choose to Opt Out
- Stagger Staff Vaccines (if possible) Avoid All Staff Recovering Simultaneously
- Prepare a Staff Contingency Plan (for Recoveries and Opt Outs)
- Ramp Up Education Around Vaccine Safety and Efficacy

What Advantage of Being First?

Recommendations

- Turn Vaccination into Opportunity for Pro-Active, Positive Messaging
 - Prospective Residents: safest place you can be; safer than home
 - Prospective Staff: safer than any other industry; we have vaccines
 - Referrals Channels: safer than any other setting; safer than a hospital
 - Press/Media: redemption ... we persevered, and we now stand strong

1. Distribution & Logistics

Timing of first vaccines? Is there enough for staff AND residents? Who will administer after CVS/Walgreens? Can you do this on your own?

2. Staff Buy-in & Compliance

How to optimize? What messaging? What motivators (bonus pay/mandates/lead by example)?

3. Resident Buy-in & Compliance

How to maximize? What role for families/physicians?

4. Liability Mitigation

Does vaccine increase or decrease liability exposure? Should residents sign release forms; "refusal to vaccinate" forms?

5. Staffing Shortage

Will the vaccine help? "Work for us and you'll get vaccinated."

6. Building Back Census/Occupancy

Does the vaccine change the dynamic? "Move into SL and get vaccinated first". Same question for short-stay SNF patients?

7. Back to Business

Is a vaccine an accelerator to a return to "normal" – group dining, group activities, and family visitation?

8. Vendor Visitation

How does this impact other providers/partners entering our buildings? Should we require them to be vaccinated?
